Join the WSU Vancouver Dept. of Public Safety for a free CPR/First Aid class on Friday, November 6, 2009 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM [Pre-registration required/limited space available].

Certification for this course is provided in the form of American Heart Association CPR/First Aid cards - issued at the end of the course upon satisfactory completion of the skills testing segment. Course material covered in this class includes First Aid, Adult/Child/Infant CPR, AED (Automated External Defibrillator), and Environmental Emergencies.

Students are strongly encouraged to wear comfortable clothing and come prepared to spend a portion of the day on floor mats for CPR skills practice and testing. Due to the physical nature of the course content, please contact an instructor prior to class registration if you have any concerns about the skills testing portion of the class.

Although scheduled until 5:00 PM, classes will often finish earlier than the scheduled end time. Instructors will remain in the class until 5:00 PM with anyone wishing further information or practice time for any segment of the class.

Intermittent breaks will be taken throughout the day, including a 30 - 45 minute lunch on your own. Due to the certification requirements of the class, students arriving late will not be eligible to complete the skills test or receive a certification card.

Students must be present for all segments of the class to receive certification.
