WHAT IS TEEN-WORKS?

Teen-Works is a program of the WSU Vancouver Center for Youth Workforce Preparation. It provides training and "hands-on" experience for teens.

WHAT DO YOU DO IN TEEN-WORKS?

Teen-Works is run like a Community College. Teens select Exploration Tracks they are interested in and work as part of an exploration team. Each team has 8-12 members and volunteer instructor.

Teens meet with their instructor for six - eight learning sessions on the WSU Vancouver campus. Sessions are normally held 6:30-8pm twice monthly. Members have access to loaned computers and other tools. Members develop and maintain their own resume' and personnel file.

WHAT ARE EXPLORATION TRACKS?

Exploration Tracks are constantly changing. They are based on interest and available resources. *Examples* of Tracks scheduled for the fall include:
