1. Meet with an Honors Advisor to discuss the Senior Thesis/Project. _____
2. Select a faculty member who will serve as your supervisor during your project. _____
3. Submit a written proposal and completed application to the Honors Senior Thesis/Project Committee by the appropriate deadline. _____
4. When your proposal is accepted, register for the appropriate course in one or more semesters. (Remember you need a total of three credits to complete this requirement.) _____
5. Maintain regular contact with your faculty mentor while working on your Senior Thesis/Project. _____
6. Complete all of your research and writing requirements before the last semester of your academic program. _____
7. Submit presentation request form at least 4 week in advance of first proposed date. _____
8. Submit two copies (four copies if WHETs'd to Pullman) to Honors Program Support by Monday of the week prior to your scheduled presentation. _____
9. Participate in the Honors Program Research Fair where you will present your work. _____
