The general studies degree options offer students an exciting opportunity to complete a bachelor's degree by combining course work in two or three academic fields in humanities or social sciences. The structure of our general studies degrees allows students to move away from specializing in one field of study and gives them a chance to gain a breadth of knowledge by completing academic work in several related fields. Humanities fields include Digital Technology and Culture, English, Fine Arts, History, and Women's Studies. Social Sciences fields include Anthropology, Criminal Justice, History, Political Science, Psychology, and Sociology.
