

BSN for Registered Nurses

Intercollegiate College of Nursing

Description

The BSN for Registered Nurses program is designed for RNs with an accredited Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) from a community college or a diploma in nursing from a hospital-based nursing school. A flexible program designed to meet the needs of working nurses; RN students learn new techniques and improve essential skills. The program consists of four semesters of full-time study; part-time options are available. Additional study options are available for RNs who are also seeking a graduate degree in nursing.

Courses

Prerequisites include Anatomy & Physiology, Chemistry course with lab, Human Nutrition, Intro to Sociology, Intro to Psychology, Microbiology and Statistics. Computer and internet skills are essential. Some of the courses in the program include:

- ◆ Professional Nursing Concepts and Issues
- ◆ Assessment & Application of Physiological Concepts I & II
- ◆ Nursing Research & Informatics
- ◆ Ethics in Health Care
- ◆ Community Health Nursing Concepts and Practice
- ◆ Psychiatric Mental health Nursing Concepts and Practice
- ◆ Nursing Leadership and Nursing Management

Career Opportunities

With the BSN degree from WSU, the RN is prepared for graduate study (a requirement for nurse practitioners and clinical nurse specialists), specialization, and nursing management. The BSN graduate re-enters the workforce well equipped to provide leadership, improve patient care, and apply research in practice.
